# What it costs

- Budget – 2009: €2.7m
- Exchequer contribution: €1.35m (approx.)
- PABs' contribution: €1.35m (approx.)

# Objectives

- Promote and protect the public interest;
- Support and enhance confidence in financial reporting;
- Support and enhance confidence in the manner in which the profession is regulated and monitored; and
- Contribute to the enhancement of Ireland's standing as a low risk and reputable place to do business.

# Some specific challenges to the attainment of Objectives

- Domestic and international economic downturn (e.g. going concern);
- Valuation of assets (e.g. illiquid markets, impairments etc.);
- Increased use of experts/models;
- Increased complexity of business/transactions/standards;
- All resulting in significant additional challenges for preparers, auditors and regulators/supervisors.

# Outputs/Benefits to stakeholders

- Guidance on complex regulatory requirements;
- Feedback to preparers' Boards, management and ACs;
- Recommendations/directions to improve (PABs);
- Undertakings/publication of revised information (issuers);
- Enquiries – examination of possible non-compliance and, if confirmed, remediation;
- Supervision of investigations (independent assurance).



# Forthcoming developments

## Statutory Audit Directive

- QA – statutory basis;
- Recommendation;
- Common standards;
- 3<sup>rd</sup> county dimension.

# Priorities

- Continued enhancement of standard of financial reporting and the PABs' regulatory activities;
- Response to recent high profile issues;
- Continued provision of guidance and feedback;
- Implementation of Directive in final form as determined by the Minister.
