

Establishment of a Panel of Legal Professionals

Pursuant to the Companies Acts, one of the principal functions of the Irish Auditing & Accounting Supervisory Authority ('IAASA') is to supervise the Prescribed Accountancy Bodies' regulation and monitoring of their members and member firms.

In discharging this function, IAASA, on occasion, requires the services of suitably qualified legal professionals. In that context, IAASA wishes to establish a Panel of such persons and is inviting expressions of interest from legal professionals (including retired members of the Judiciary) possessing a high level of relevant expertise and experience in the following areas:

- civil litigation;
- regulatory law (ideally in the context of the regulation of professions);
- law of evidence;
- professional and legal privilege;
- statutory interpretation.

Expressions of interest should provide, at a minimum, the following information:

- name, address and contact details;
- details of qualifications;
- details of relevant expertise and experience in the areas outlined; and
- an indication as to general availability.

Expressions of interest, which should be submitted by **Friday, 12 March, 2010** and marked 'LP-RMS', should be sent for consideration to the **Chief Executive, Irish Auditing & Accounting Supervisory Authority, Willow House, Millennium Park, Naas, Co. Kildare, Ireland** or emailed to submissions@iaasa.ie.

IAASA further reserves full discretion to consult with and appoint persons who are not on the Panel whenever it considers it advisable, or otherwise appropriate, to do so.
